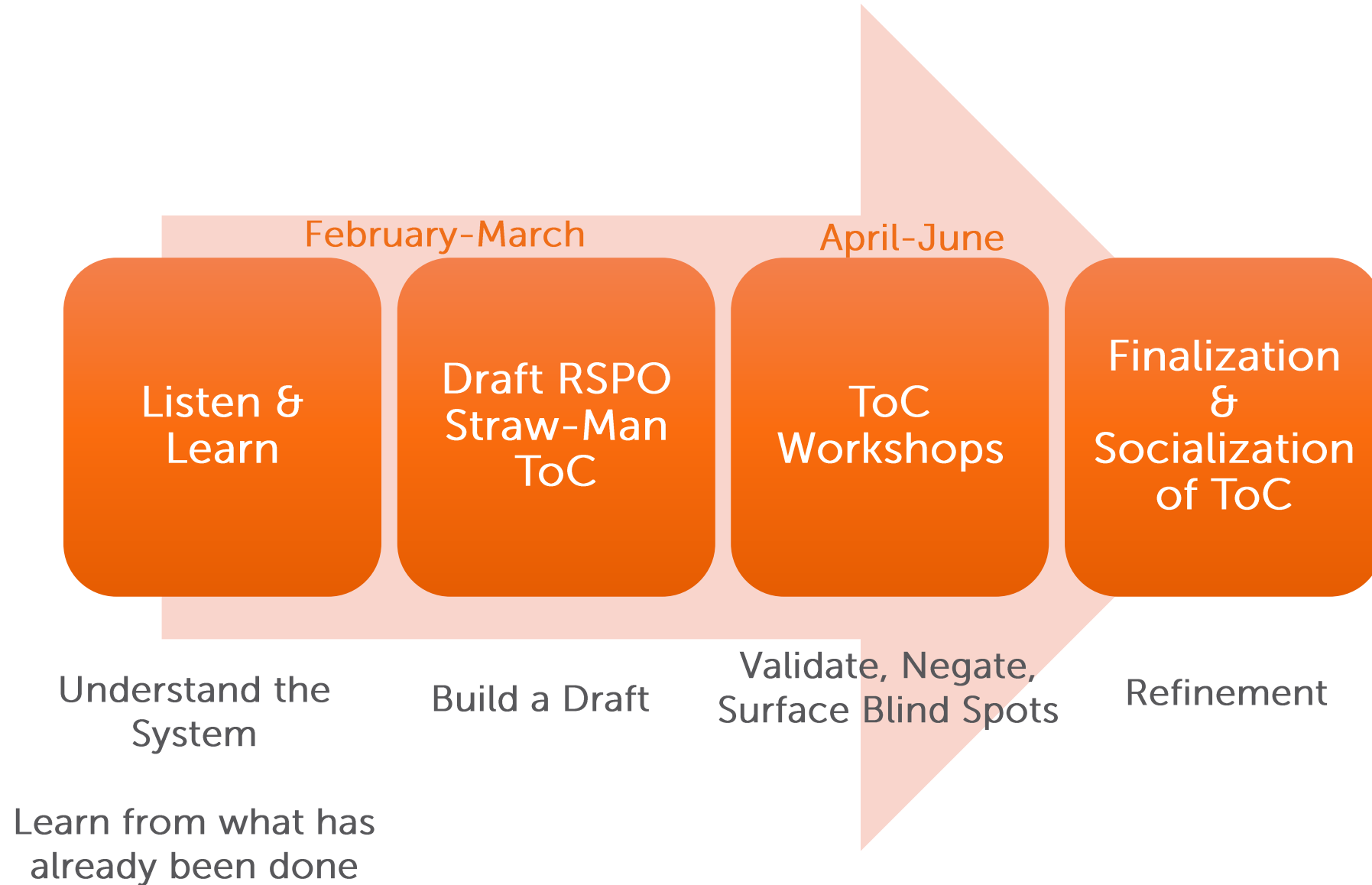
What Is A Theory Of Change (ToC)?

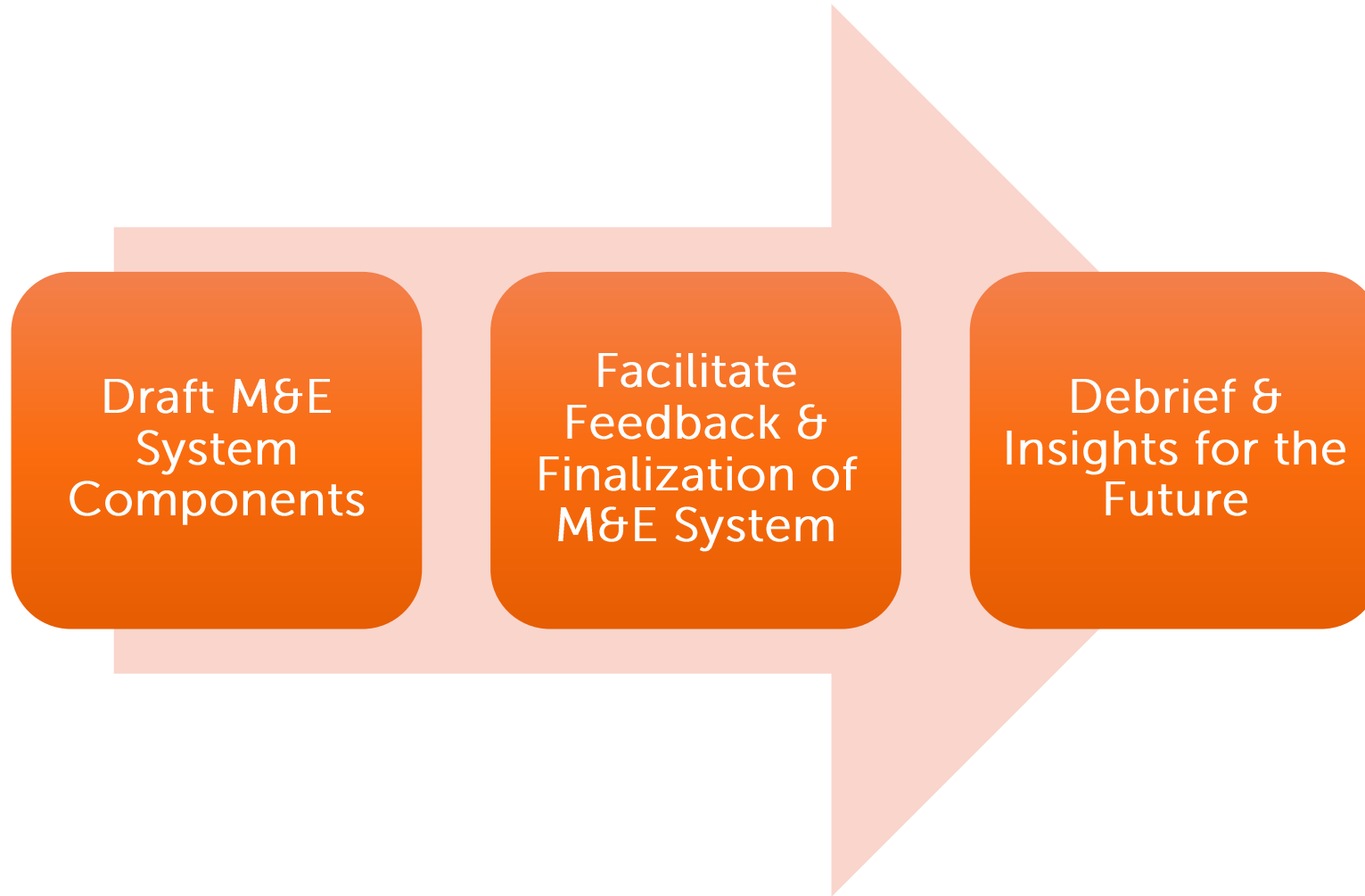
A Theory of Change articulates both **what** impact or change the organisation is hoping to achieve and **how** its work brings about that change.

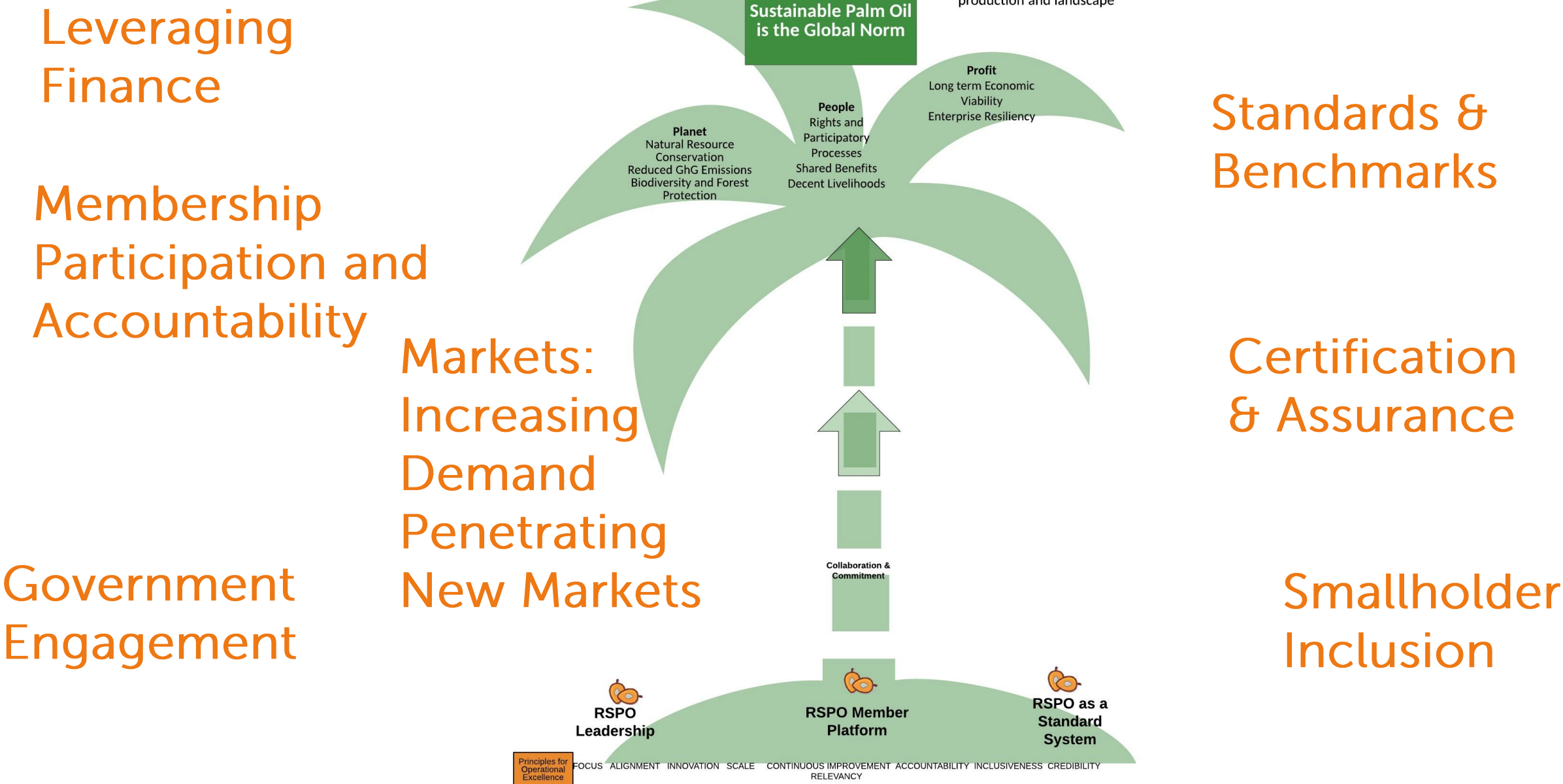


- Creates a commonly understood vision of the long term goals and strategy for achieving those goals
